- Undertake work necessary for the integration of PCE equipment into customers machinery/facility. This could include electrical, mechanical, pneumatic or software tasks.
- Fault finding and repair of electrical, pneumatic, and mechanical systems.
- Perform maintenance inspections and tasks at customer premises.
- Provide exceptional levels of customer service.
- Participate in internal design reviews on existing or potential projects.
